

Effective collaboration

If the applicant is effectively collaborating with one (or several) other stakeholder(s) for the implementation of the project, the percentage of the contribution may be increased by 15%, with a maximum limit of 80%.

Effective collaboration refers to any partnership in which the stakeholders:

- participate jointly in the design of the project,
- contribute together to its implementation and
- share the risks and results

Sub-contracting is not seen as effective collaboration and does not entitle applicants to an increase in the level of contribution.

2 types of effective collaboration can be differentiated:

Cooperation with one or more national or international companies

Brussels-based company + Belgian or EU or independent company(ies) in terms of shareholding:

- Budget per partner \leq 70% of the total budget
- Only Brussels partners are eligible for Innoviris aids

Cooperation with a research organization:

Brussels-based company + independent research center(s):

- Budget per partner \leq 70% of the total budget
- Total budget of the research organizations involved in the projects between a minimum of 10% and a maximum of 70% of the total budget
- Right to publication of the results conducted by the research organization
- Only Brussels partners are eligible for Innoviris aids
